

Required Admissions Documents

Document	Description / Notes
Statement of financial position from bank in home country	Demonstrates the ability of the parents to pay tuition in full, living expenses, and other incidental expenses for a minimum period of at least 1 year.
Affidavit of support from parents	Clearly specifies the following: 1) The parents agree to be financially responsible for all costs associated with the student's period of enrollment at Emerson Preparatory School 2) The name and contact information of the student's intended guardian or sponsor while the student is in the United States.
Letter from United States guardian or sponsor	Clearly indicates that the guardian accepts responsibility for student's well-being while the student is in the United States.
Medical and immunization records	Immunization records must include a detailed list of immunizations received and the specific date(s) of immunization.
Copy of passport	To be compared with original upon arrival
Copy of birth certificate	

Completed application	Application form available on admissions page of Emerson's website.
An application fee: \$100.00	Receipt of this non-refundable fee is required prior to the processing of any admissions related documents.
Three letters of recommendation	Recommendation letters should describe the student's character, academic capability, performance in one or more classes, academic strengths and weaknesses, motivation, and level of emotional maturity. No particular format is required.
Official copies of student's transcript	If credit system of current school is not based upon "Carnegie Units of Credit," which are used by the majority of schools in the United States, a key clearly explaining the current school's method of assigning credit must accompany any transcript.

Important Notes for International Applicants

All documents must be written or translated into English

A \$1,000.00 non-refundable deposit must be paid to Emerson prior to its submission of an I-20 request to the United States Government.

Tuition for 1 year must be paid in full prior to the start date of the student
